Illinois Southern Baptist Disaster Relief is operating in Lake County to help people recover from the recent flooding and have a number of ways to help.

ISBDR will be distributing 5 gallon buckets filled with cleaning supplies and personnel safety equipment as shown in the picture. The buckets provided by the North American Mission Board will be passed out free of charge. SBDR will also make available up to 2 gallons of premixed Shockwave for each family. ShockWave is a hospital grade EPA registered disinfectant, sanitizer, fungicide, virucide, bactericide, and cleaner for use on porous and non-porous surfaces. To receive the shockwave, you need to bring a sealable container or clean garden sprayer will also work. These free resources will be passed out on Saturday July 29th at two locations from 9 AM-2 PM:

Illinois Southern Baptist church also has work teams available to provide hands on help with flood recovery. Once a person fills out a request for assistance, our teams will assess your home and then will remove contaminated materials and drywall and sanitize the structure with Shockwave. The assistance requests forms can be filled out at the two locations and times above or you can contact the Incident Command Center at 1-217-622-5101. Renters need to have both themselves and their landlord sign assistance request forms.

We will send a trained assessor to the house to assess the damage and make recommendations to you. When homes have been flooded our teams respond to help after the waters have receded. Mud and debris are removed. Wet drywall and floors must be torn out and damaged furniture carried outside. Sometimes washers, dryers, hot water heaters and furnaces must also be removed. Treatments are then applied to kill mold and keep it from returning. This ministry is one of the most requested needs in Disaster Relief. Recovery trailers carry the needed supplies and equipment for this area of ministry. We look for items that may be important to you and save them for you to inspect. We place all the debris outside the residence. We do not just clean the mud off the floors and leave. That is dangerous to you and your family. We could do a clean-up in an unfinished basement. We recommend that all contaminated items must be removed for inspection. There is no cost to our services.
